Subject: Anti-bribery policy To prevent corruption and misconduct (Anti-Bribery Policy)

According to the Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption 2018, Section 128, paragraph one, which states that No government official is allowed to receive property or any other benefits that may be calculated as income from anyone. In addition to property or benefits that should be obtained according to laws, rules or regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of the law. Except for receiving property or any other benefits. By ethics according to the criteria and amounts specified by the NACC and according to the Civil Service Code of Ethics, Section 6 (1), do not demand or agree to receive or allow others to request or agree to accept gifts on behalf of you. Oneself or one's relatives, whether before or after holding office or performing duties, whether related or not related to the performance of duties or not. Unless it is given according to ethics. Or is it given according to tradition or to the general public In order to prevent corruption and misconduct. of government officials at all levels To work with transparency, auditability and compliance with the law. Bannongmek Provincial Police Station Therefore, guidelines for anti-bribery practices have been established. To prevent corruption and misconduct Police officers at all levels must follow the guidelines as follows:

1. Do not ask about Do not give or accept bribes, gifts, souvenirs, tokens or any other benefits from performing duties.
2. Not accepting assets or any other benefits
3. Do not allow or connivance for family members to give or accept bribes, gifts, tokens or other benefits to those involved in the performance of duties.
4. Refusing, not tolerating, not being indifferent to the behavior of accepting bribes, gifts, tokens or any other benefits from performing duties. If any violating action is found, inform the superintendent/head of the police station as soon as possible.


5. Reduce the giving or receiving of assets or any other benefits on an ethical basis in accordance with the rules. and the number determined by the Office of the NACC, using means of expression by signing greeting cards, greeting books, and condolence cards. or using social media instead of giving things

6. In the case where it is necessary to give or receive property or any other benefit on an ethical or traditional basis or to maintain goodwill, friendship, and good relations between people. Before giving or receiving gifts and souvenirs Gifts or other benefits must make sure has complied with relevant laws and regulations by things or gifts or any other benefits given or received to each other There must be value in receiving from the individual. Each occasion does not exceed 3,000 baht. If it exceeds 3,000 baht, report the receipt of the gift to the supervisor. Be careful underestimating the value of gifts or any other benefits.

Therefore, it has been announced and strictly adhered to.
